



HARVEST

Going, Going, Gone! While it may be a bit premature to hail “Last Call” for our 2007 Russian River Pinot, we have good reason for being more than a bit nervous. Reflecting back on conditions that resulted in an extremely light harvest, production plummeted a whopping 60%! Translation.....Mother Nature short changed us by nearly 550 cases of wine. On the other hand, small harvests often result in wines of tremendous depth and concentration.

THE WINE

If you’ve come to enjoy our Russian River Pinot Noir you’ve become accustomed to a Rich, Vibrant, Masculine pinot that is equally at home when paired with grilled salmon or a 21 day, dry-aged steak! While shamelessly bold and distinctly full-bodied it respectfully stays true to the essence of pinot noir. Exotic aromas of succulent red fruits, pomegranate combined with cracked cinnamon sticks and freshly turned earth are the hallmarks of our Russian River Pinot Noir. An expansive, supple and velvety texture will seduce even the die-hard cabernet palate. A long, satisfying finish is reached through a delicate balance of fruit, tannins, minerality, toasty oak and mouth-watering acidity.
